

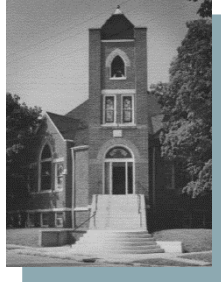

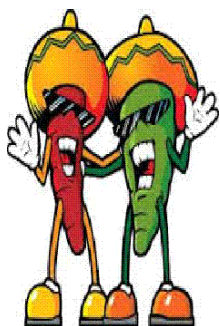

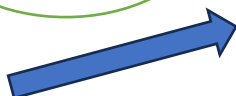

The word, Easter, comes not from a Christian source, but from an ancient ritual. An illustrious monk and writer of the medieval church, the Venerable Bede (673-735, wrote that the term is a corruption of Eostre, the Teutonic goddess of spring. The label was chosen because of the time of year when the feast of the resurrection is always held.

Why is Easter celebrated in spring?

According to the NT, Jesus was crucified on Friday afternoon a few hours before the start of the high holy season called Passover. His resurrection was on the following Sunday, thus the Christian celebration of Easter has always been linked with the Jewish observance of Passover.

The first council of the Christian Church (held in Nicaea in 325) set the date for the celebration of Jesus' resurrection as the first Sunday after the first full moon following the vernal equinox. The earliest possible date of Easter is March 22 and the latest possible date is April 25.

Eastern Orthodox churches follow the Julian calendar rather than the Gregorian calendar, so their celebration normally follows one week later than most Christian denominations.
